The following Terms and Conditions must be met and accepted in order for you to waive your enrollment in the JRS.

- I understand N.J.S.A. 43:6A-14b does not permit the receipt of a pension from another New Jersey State-administered retirement system while I am serving on the Bench and a contributing member of the JRS.
- I understand that if I am enrolled in another New Jersey State-administered retirement system and my former employer is a county, municipality, board of education, or authority, my retirement benefit must be due and payable (30 days after the effective retirement date or 30 days after the Board of Trustees approval date, whichever is the later date) prior to my appointment to the Bench.
- I understand that if I am enrolled in another New Jersey State-administered retirement system and wish to retire and collect my full pension benefit from the previous membership, I must have at least a 180-day break in service prior to my judicial appointment date.
- I understand that once my retirement benefit from another New Jersey State-administered retirement system is due and payable, I may not cancel that retirement and elect to enroll in the JRS.
- I understand that if I die prior to the retirement date listed on my retirement application with the prior retirement system, my beneficiary may elect any retirement survivorship benefits, if applicable, that I may have selected for my beneficiary after retirement in lieu of any active employee death benefits based on the rules of my prior retirement system membership. The retirement survivorship benefits, if elected by a beneficiary, will not become effective until my retirement date. My beneficiary may elect instead to receive active employee death benefits based on the rules of my prior retirement system membership. These benefits will not be based on the active death benefits payable from the JRS.
- I understand that once I waive enrollment in the JRS, I may not later request to cancel my retirement from the prior New Jersey State-administered retirement system in order to enroll in the JRS.
- I understand that by accepting a full retirement benefit from another New Jersey State-administered retirement system, my retirement service and retired coverage eligibility for health benefits purposes is determined by the last employer that I worked for in that system. I understand, however, that I may participate in the New Jersey State Health Benefits Program (SHBP) while serving on the Bench.
- I understand that by waiving my right to enrollment in the JRS, I forfeit all rights and privileges to the JRS retirement benefits set forth in N.J.S.A. 43:6A et seq.
