RESOLUTION 2022-1 FINAL AGENCY DECISIONS ON REMANDED APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO THE 2018 REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS PROCESS

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2018, the Department of Health ("Department") posted a Request for Applications ("RFA") to award up to six vertically integrated Alternative Treatment Centers ("ATCs"), with up to two awardees in each of the three New Jersey Regions – North, Central and South; and

WHEREAS, in response to the RFA, the Department received 146 timely applications submitted by 103 applicants, with several applicants submitting applications to operate ATCs in multiple regions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:64-6.2 (now N.J.A.C. 17:30A-6.2 and 6.4), the Department convened a selection committee of six individuals to review and score all applications; and

WHEREAS, review and scoring of the applications was completed on December 12, 2018, when the selection committee recommended six applications per region for "further consideration" of an ATC permit award by the Department; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2018, the Department issued final agency decisions to all applicants, expressing either acceptance or rejection of their applications; and

WHEREAS, several unsuccessful applicants appealed the Department's decisions, with all appeals being consolidated as <u>Matter of the Application for Medicinal Marijuana Alternative Treatment Ctr. for Pangaea Health & Wellness, LLC</u>, 465 N.J. Super. 343 (App. Div. 2020); and

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2020, the Court rendered an opinion vacating the final agency decisions of seven applicants and remanded the matter back to the Department for

further administrative proceedings; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2021, the Court upheld the Department's process for conducting further administrative proceedings as consistent with the Court's November 25, 2020, ruling; and

WHEREAS, the authority to regulate and enforce activities related to medicinal cannabis previously was vested in the Department, and now vests in the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("the Commission") pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153; and

WHEREAS, Commission staff executed a plan to establish an administrative review process in conformity with the spirit of the Court's opinion to allow for further agency proceedings concerning the 2018 RFA process, including providing the appellant applicants the opportunity to submit supplemental information regarding their applications; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Commission and his staff have extensive knowledge of the 2018 RFA, with several staff members having been involved in the process as far back as the posting of the RFA by the Department in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Commission and his staff have executed the established administrative review plan and completed a quality control review of the 2018 RFA process, including a review of the appellants' applications and scoring; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Commission has provided the Commissioners with his recommendation report regarding the appropriate action to be taken to satisfy the Court's remand and address patient needs within the medicinal marijuana industry; and

WHEREAS, the following list of appellants have had their applications reviewed and, pursuant to the spirit of the Court's remand, were put through a quality control process implemented by the Commission:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission that:

1. Pursuant to the terms of the 2018 RFA, and in accordance with the methodology outlined by Executive Director Jeff Brown in the attached Recommendation Memorandum and following the rigorous quality control process implemented by the Commission following remand by the Superior Court, Appellate Division, the following applications for ATC vertically integrated permits are hereby **DENIED**.
