**RESOLUTION 2022-36**  
**APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS TO CHANGE LOCATION FOR THREE (3) 2019**  
**REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS AWARDEES**

**WHEREAS**, P.L.2019, c.153, “Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act,” (“the Act”) authorizes a process for the receipt of applications and issuance of permits to operate Alternative Treatment Centers (“ATCs”) in the state of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the authority to regulate and enforce activities related to medicinal cannabis previously was vested in the New Jersey Department of Health (“the Department”), and now vests in the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“the Commission”) pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2019, the Department published a Request for Applications (“RFA” or “2019 RFA”) to select entities to operate up to twenty-four (24) ATCs; and

**WHEREAS**, the RFA allowed for the issuance of endorsements and permits for up to fifteen (15) dispensaries; five (5) cultivation sites; and four (4) vertically integrated ATCs, which would grant the holder the ability to cultivate, manufacture, and dispense medicinal cannabis and medicinal cannabis products under a single permit; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 2021-16, the Commission voted to award four (4) vertically integrated permits; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolutions 2021-15 and 2021-18, the Commission voted to award ten (10) cultivation permits and thirty (30) dispensary permits to better meet market demand; and

**WHEREAS**, following execution of Resolution 2021-15 for Cultivation Awards, Resolution 2021-16 for Vertically Integrated Awards, and Resolution 2021-18 for Dispensary Awards, Final Agency Decisions (“FADs”) were issued to the ten (10) applicants deemed eligible for a cultivation award, the four (4) applicants deemed eligible for vertically integrated awards, and thirty (30) applicants deemed eligible for a dispensary award, as well as all applicants who failed to score high enough to receive award; and

**WHEREAS**, the FADs issued to each ATC pursuant to the 2019 RFA required all awardees to confirm both site control and local approval within twenty business days of the date of award; and

**WHEREAS**, at the time the twenty-day confirmation period tolled for the three (3) awardees listed further below, each had confirmed both site control and local approval for the location provided in their applications submitted pursuant to the 2019 RFA process; and

**WHEREAS**, each awardee now seeks approval to amend their application and permit award to sites in new locations, as identified in the attached Memorandum to the Board, while remaining in their region of award; and

**WHEREAS**, the regulations for medicinal cannabis provide a process at N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8 for amendments to an Alternative Treatment Center permit, including changes of the ATC's location; and

**WHEREAS**, each of these three (3) awardees has followed the requirements set forth at N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8 and submitted the requisite fee pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.10; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of these three (3) awardees' applications to amend their permits and change locations to new locations that have authorized medicinal cannabis and have approved of these awardees locating in their municipalities is beneficial to the medicinal patient population at large;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission pursuant to the terms of the 2019 RFA and N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.8 for amendments to an Alternative Treatment Center's permit, the following Alternative Treatment Centers are **APPROVED** to change their locations as proposed in their submission to the Commission:
