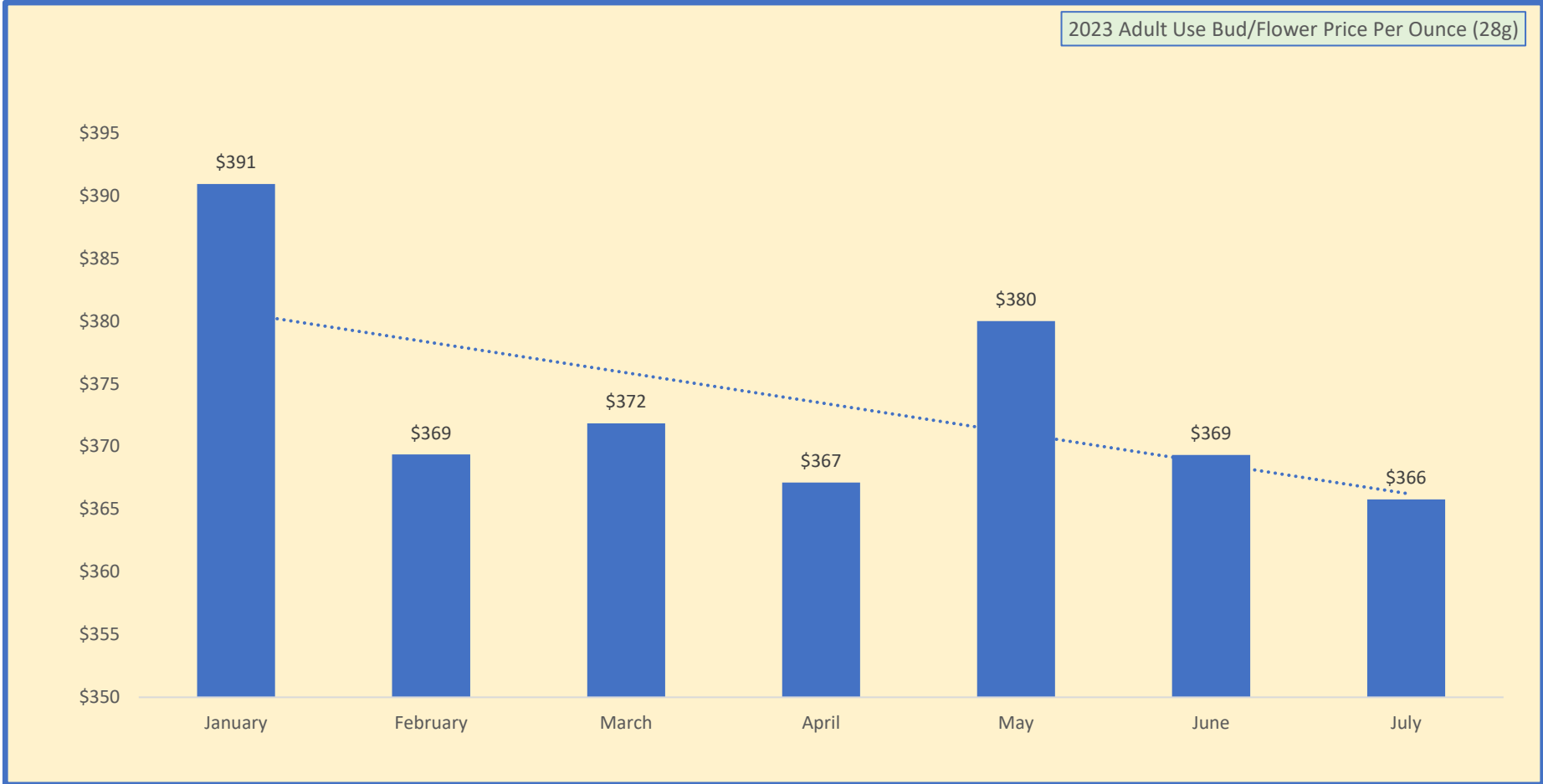

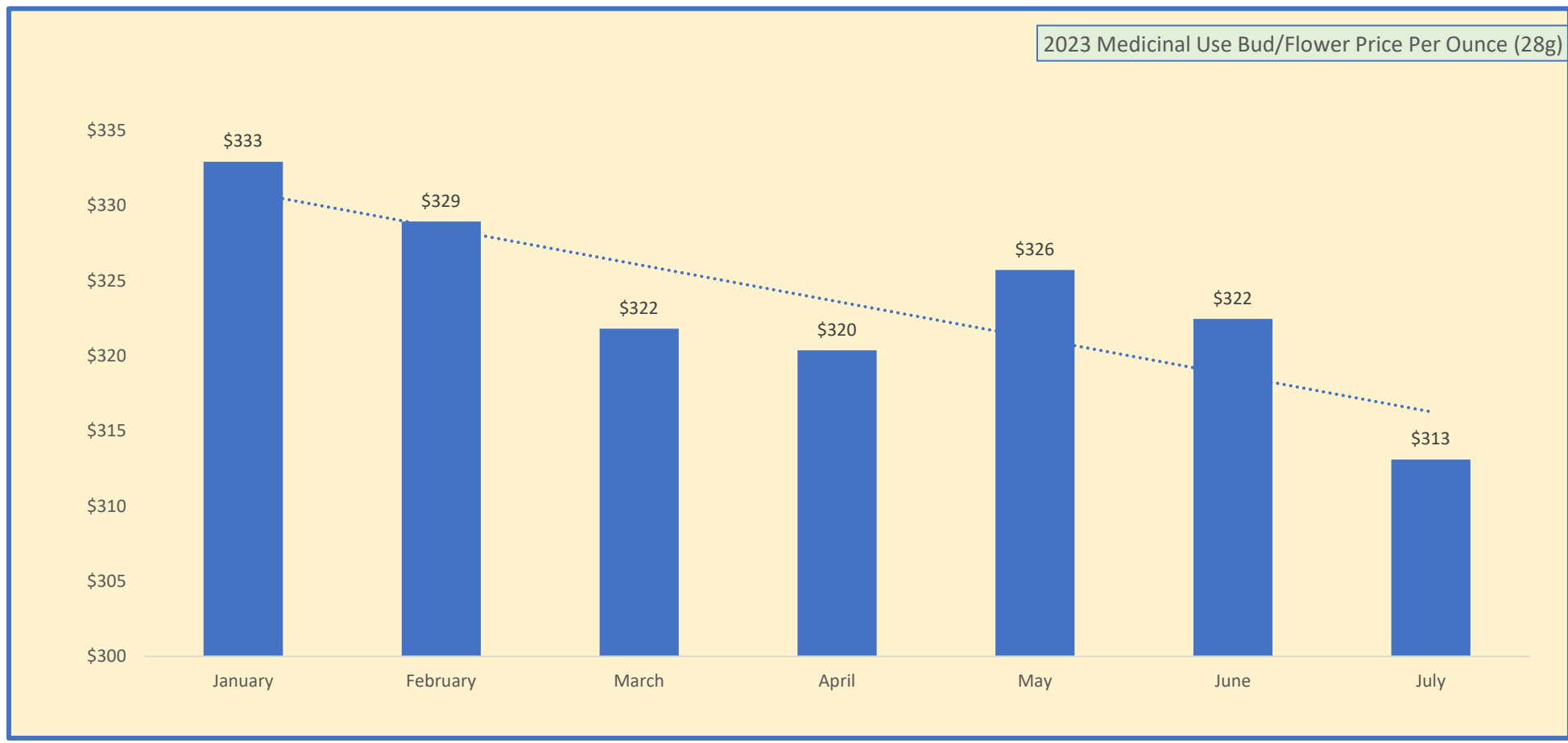

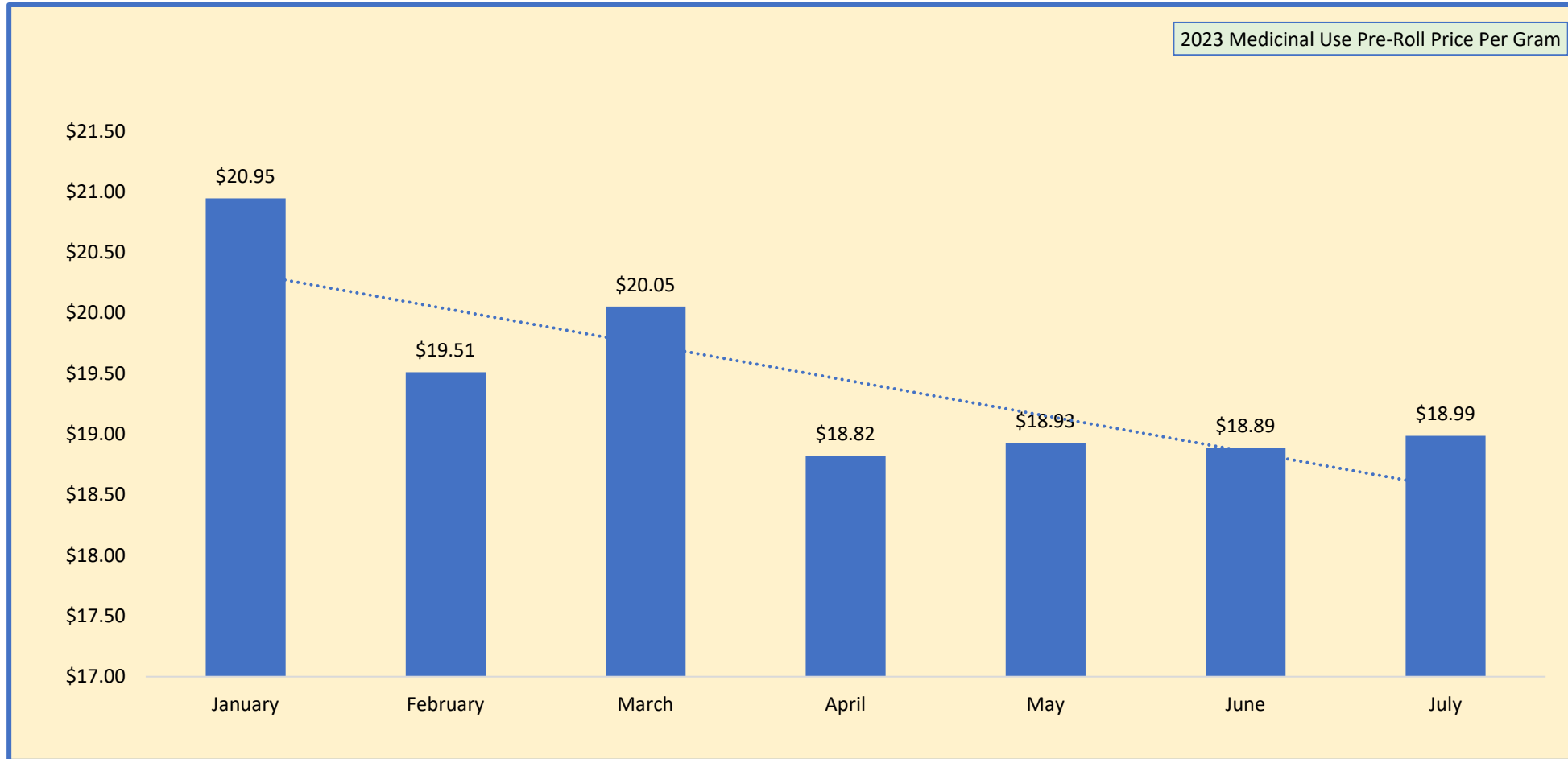

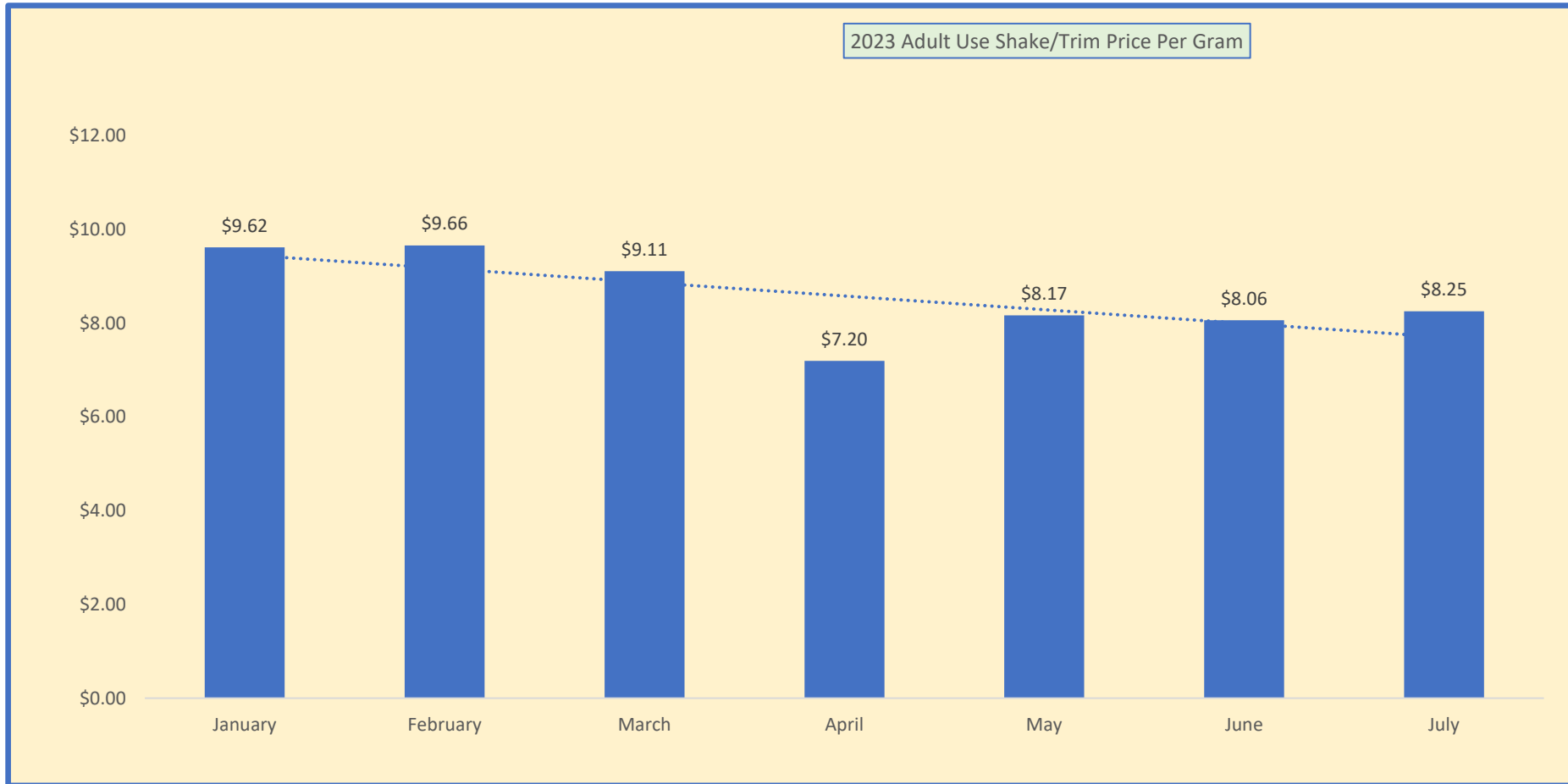

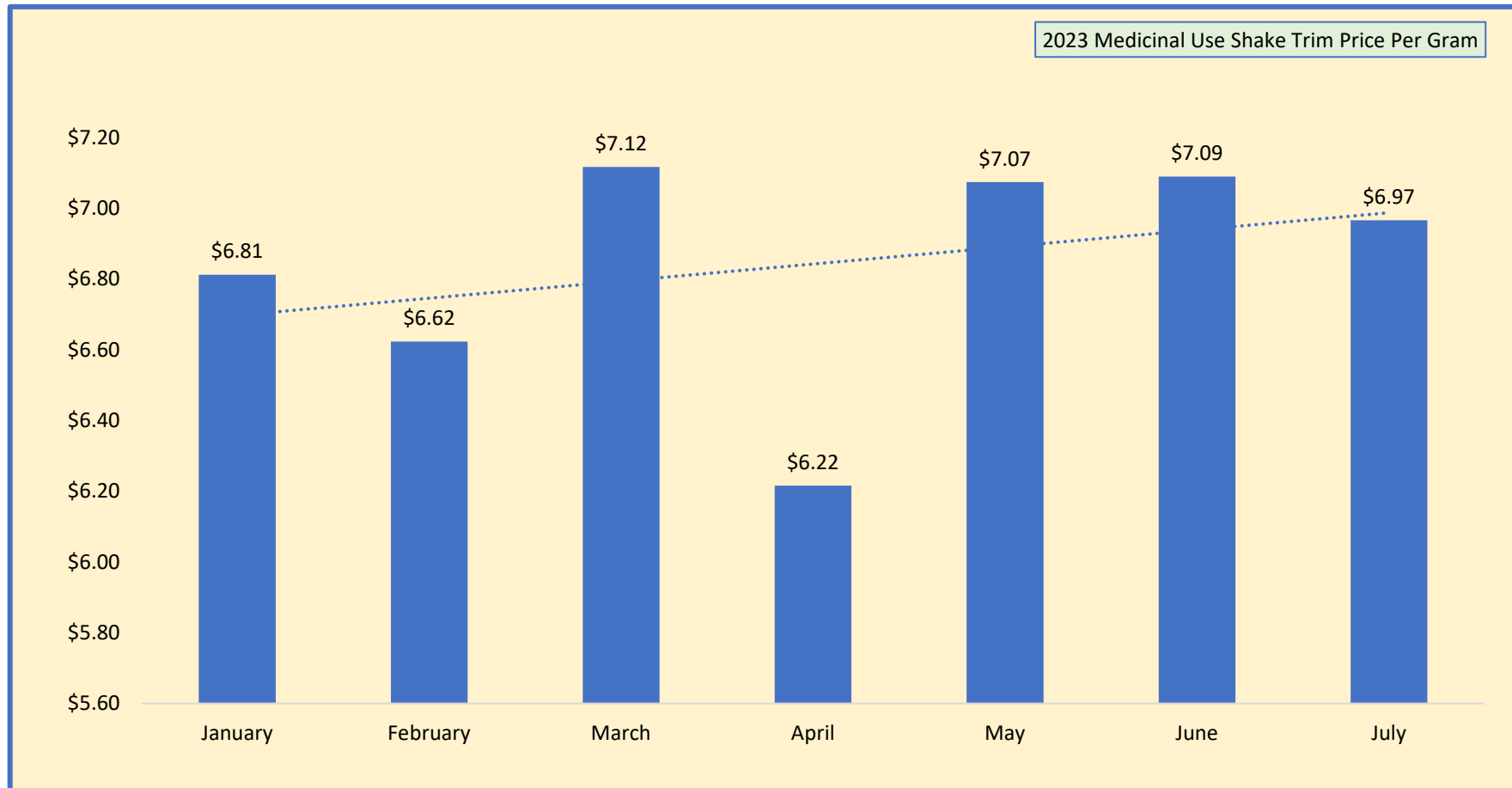

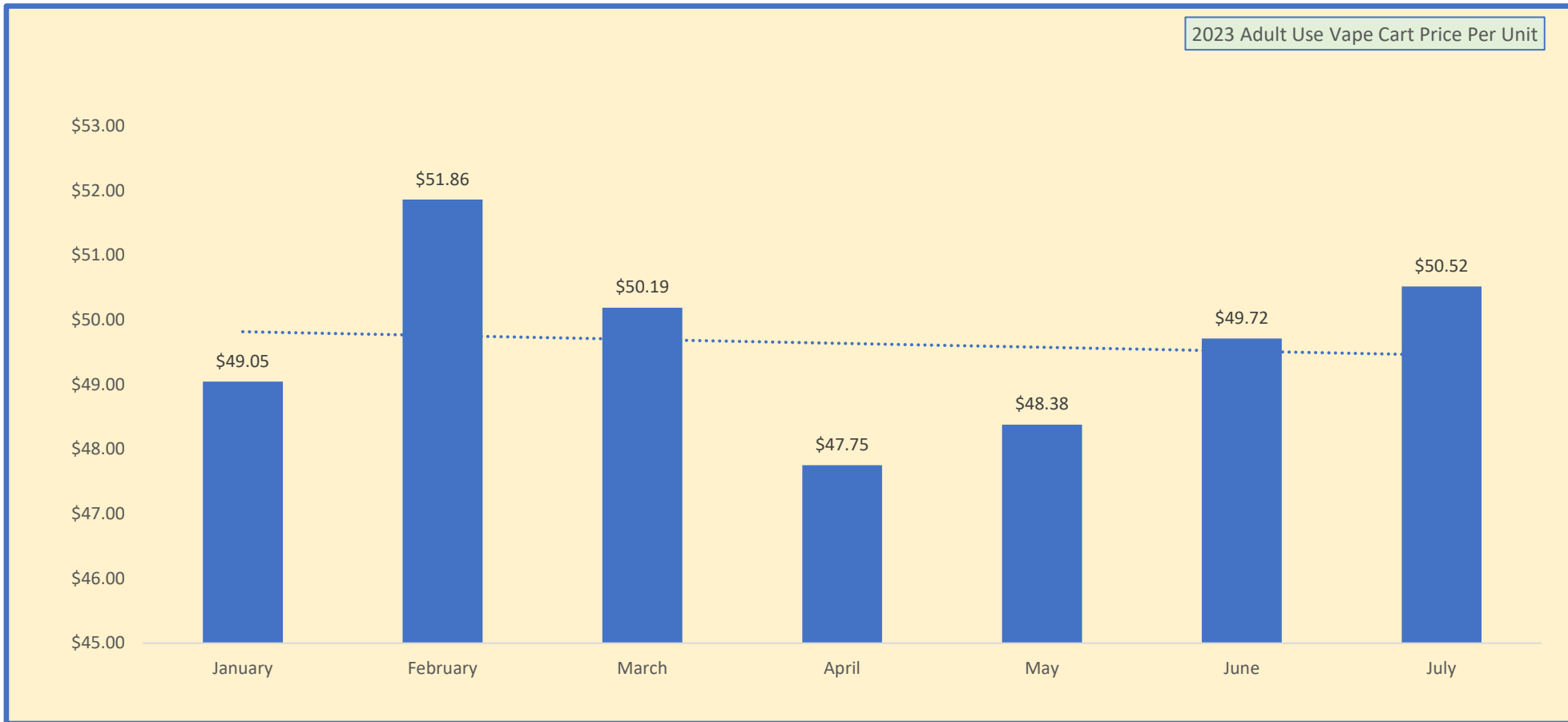

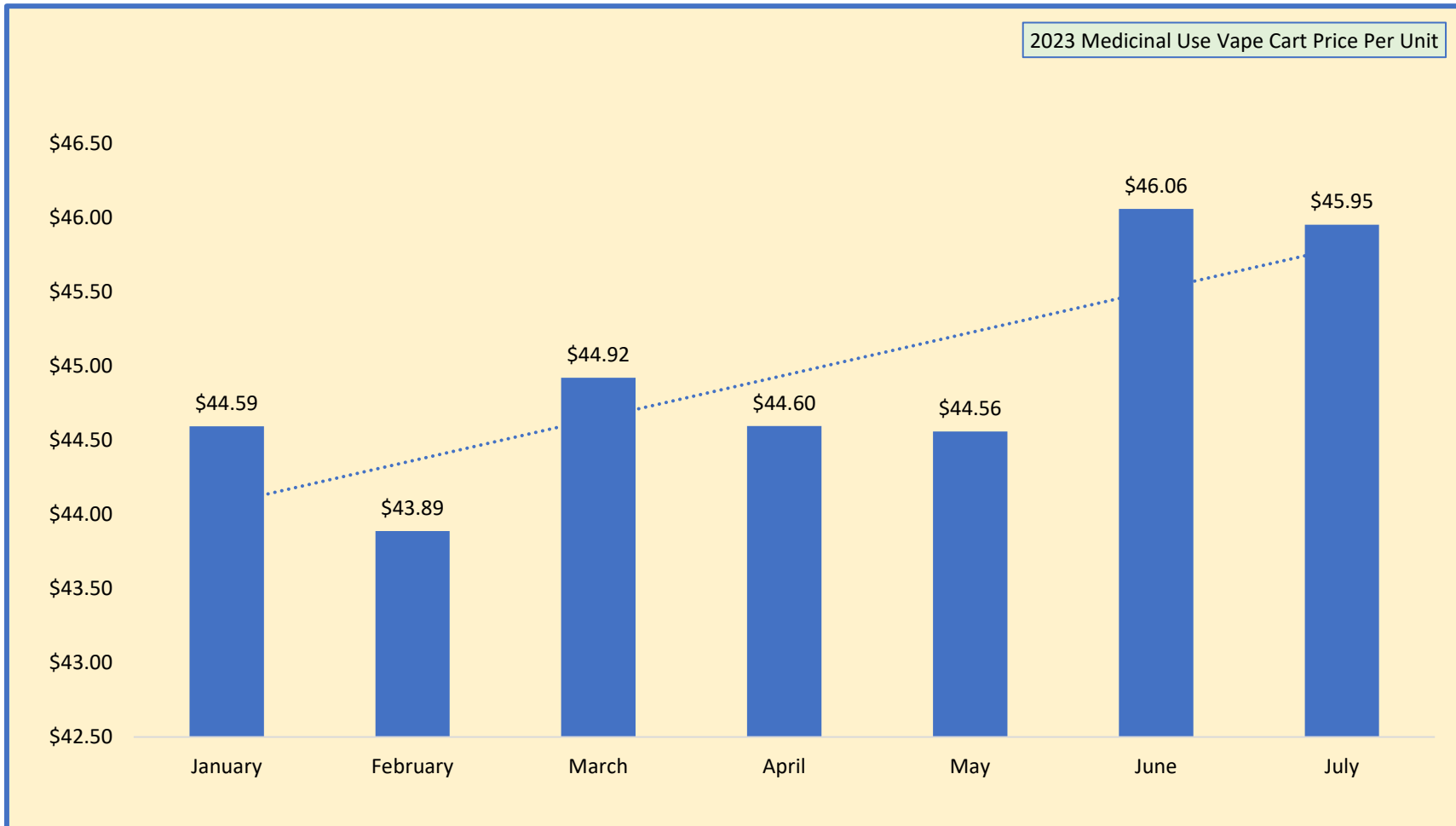

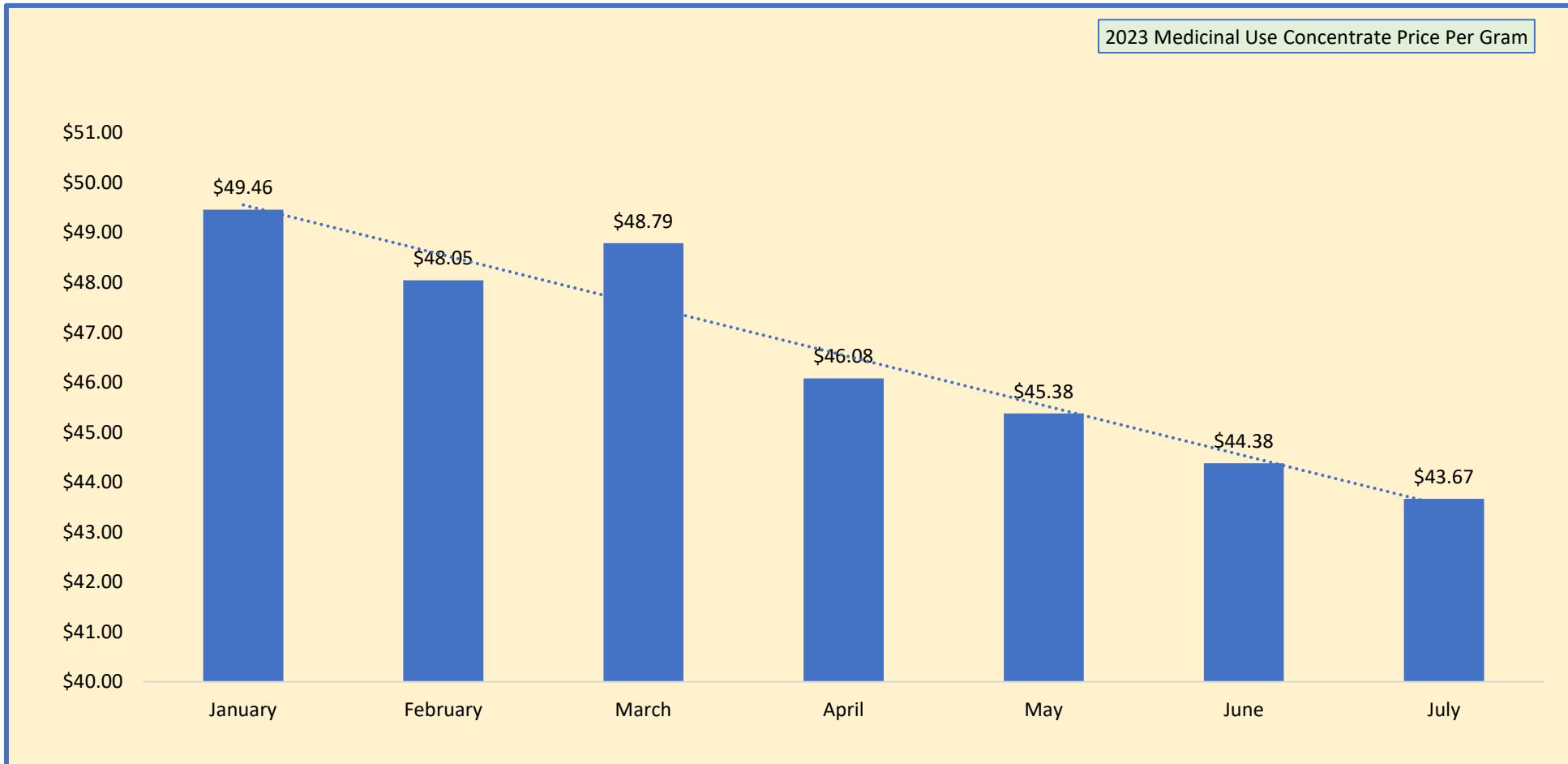

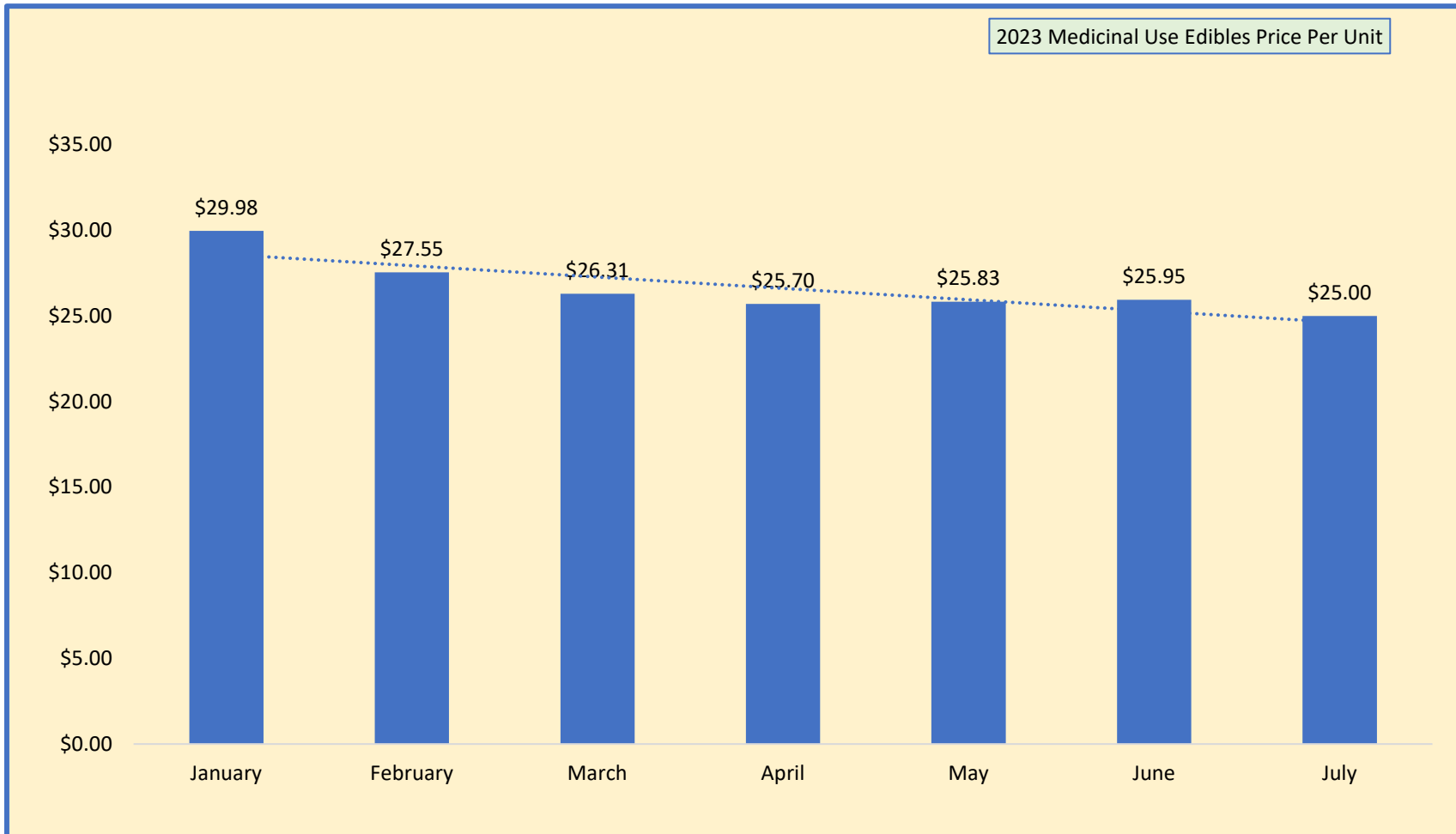

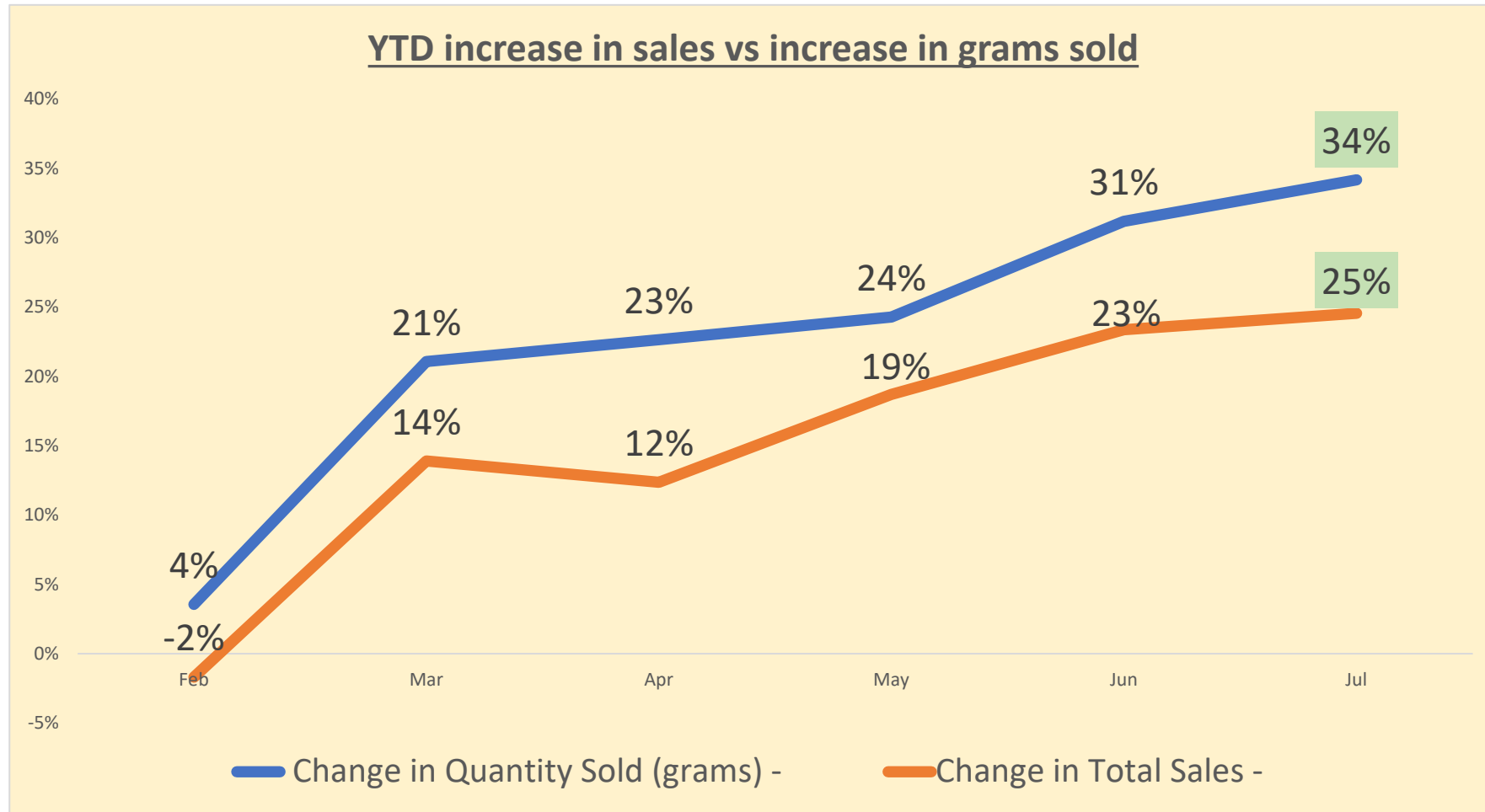

Licensing Update: Total Licenses Approved

- as of August 29, 2023

- **1208 Conditionals**
- **135 Conversion to Annual**
- **97 Annuals**
- **55 Expanded ATCs**
- **Total: 287 operating licenses awarded or issued**



Licensing Update – Applications Submitted

- as of August 29, 2023

- **Total 2,214 applications submitted**
- 1,440 applications have been approved
- 167 applications under review in the Office of Licensing
- 324 applications are pending resubmission following cure
- 140 applications under review in the Office of Compliance and Investigations
- 358 conditional conversions have been submitted



Licensing Update: Social Equity & Diversely-Owned Businesses

- Awards to Social Equity Businesses and Diversely-Owned Businesses are outpacing submission rates
 - The priority process is working.
- Social Equity Businesses = 21% of all annual awards
- Majority owners with past marijuana convictions = 16% of all awardees
- Black (17.7%) and Asian (21%) majority ownership is higher than census ownership of all businesses in New Jersey, and higher than population percentages
- Latino/Hispanic ownership is consistent with census for all businesses

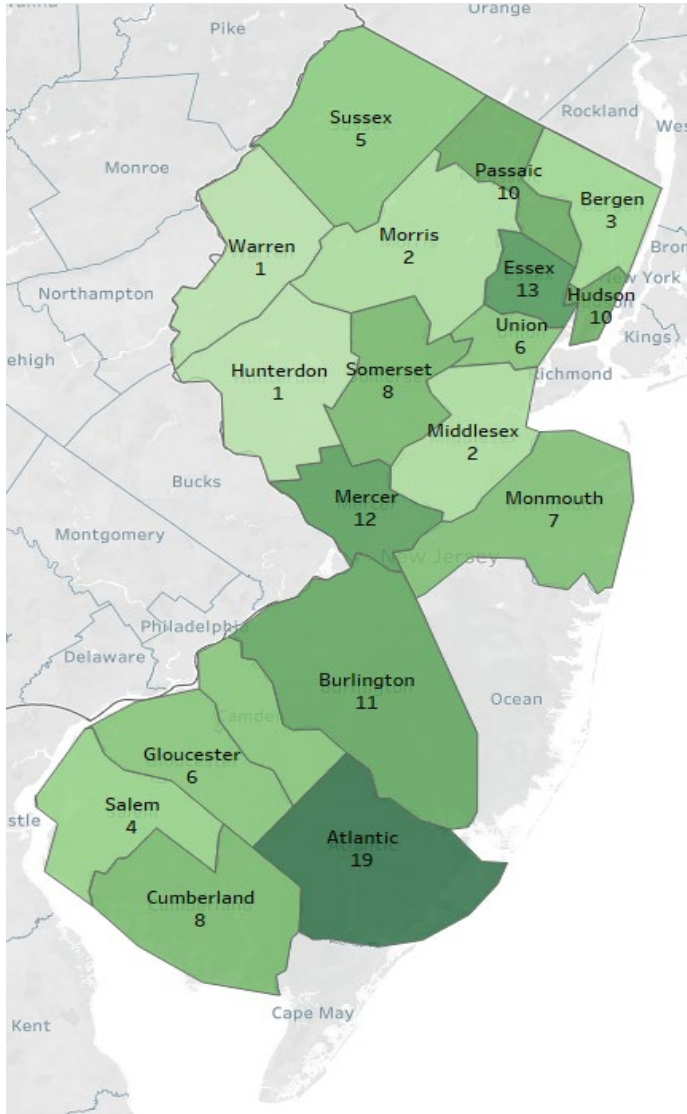

Proposed rules to expand recreational cannabis edible products

New rules would:

- **expand the types of edible cannabis products**
- **allow shelf-stable products**
 - **Examples: chocolates, baked goods, butters, and single-serve beverages**
- **Products required to be made by Class 2 Manufacturers**
- **not allow products with alcohol, tobacco, or nicotine**
- **prohibit any product that would require further cooking preparation by the consumer**



Proposed rules to expand recreational cannabis edible products

New rules would:

- **maintain existing THC limits for foods while beverages would be limited to 5 mg of THC**
- **require products be made uniformly**
- **require manufacturing staff to be trained in food safety**
- **add nutrition labels, expiration dates, and use-by information**
