**RESOLUTION 2023-182**  
**APPROVAL OF RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR MEDICINAL CANNABIS PERMITS**  
**FOR COLUMBIA CARE NEW JERSEY, LLC**

**WHEREAS**, P.L.2019, c.153, “Jake Honig Compassionate Use Medical Cannabis Act,” (“the Act”) authorizes a process for receipt of applications and issuance of permits to operate Alternative Treatment Centers (“ATCs”) in the state of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the authority to regulate and enforce activities related to medicinal cannabis previously was vested in the New Jersey Department of Health (“the Department”), and now vests in the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“the Commission”) pursuant to P.L. 2019, c.153; and

**WHEREAS**, the regulations for medicinal cannabis provide a process at N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.6 and N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7 for renewals of ATC permits; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7(b), “[t]he permit period for an [ATC] shall be from January 1st (or the date of approval of the application, if later) through December 31st of a given year”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.6, an ATC must renew its permit at the end of each year; and

**WHEREAS**, an ATC is required to submit its renewal application 60 days prior to the expiration of the permit; and

**WHEREAS**, the ATC identified below, which has been operational for one (1) year or more has submitted a full renewal application and must submit the requisite fees to renew its medicinal permits for the 2024 permit term; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has reviewed the full renewal application for this ATC for material factors that could impact the renewal of the permit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has identified concerns with the ATC’s labor practices and compliance with the Act, and wishes to gather more information from the ATC as soon as possible;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30A-7.7, the Commission has determined to renew the entity’s medicinal cannabis permit as set forth below, provided the entity complies with conditions to be set forth in the Final Agency Decision:
