Certificate of Waiver for Medicinal Marijuana Pursuant to the Provisions of the New Jersey Administrative Code Specifically, N.J.A.C. 8:64, a waiver is issued to:

ALL Caregivers

Granting relief from the following provision(s) of Chapter 8:64 of the New Jersey Administrative Code in response to the public health emergency declared in New Jersey in response to the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak:

N.J.A.C. 8:64-1.2 Definitions

"Reduced-fee eligible" means a person is:

- 1. A senior citizen or a military veteran; or
- 2. A beneficiary or recipient of:
 - i. New Jersey Medicaid;
 - ii. NJ FamilyCare;
 - iii. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP);
 - iv. New Jersey Temporary Disability Insurance (TDI);
 - v. Supplemental Security Income (SSI); or
 - vi. Social Security Disability (SSD).

N.J.A.C. 8:64-2.1 Fees for issuance and renewal of registration of qualifying patients and primary caregivers

(c) The fee to apply for issuance or renewal of a registry identification card as either a qualifying patient or a primary caregiver is \$ 100.00, unless the applicant is reduced-fee eligible, in which case, the fee to apply for issuance or renewal of a registry identification card is \$ 20.00.

The waiver is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. To incentivize the use of caregivers, all caregivers shall be deemed "reduced-fee eligible" and shall only pay a registration fee of \$20.
- 2. The waiver is limited to caregivers only.
- 3. It is applicable to registrations and renewals.

4. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:6I-4, each qualifying patient may have up to two designated caregivers.
