## **BULLETIN 79-2**

Subject: Testing of Plumbing Systems

Reference: N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.15, Plumbing Subcode, Chapter 15

This office has recently been advised that not all local plumbing subcode officials are enforcing the test requirements of the Plumbing Subcode. It might be that they have overlooked the test requirements, or because of misinterpretation or some other reason have not carried out these tests.

It is necessary that all new plumbing systems and parts of existing systems must be tested to insure they are free of leaks and defects. Where additions or changes are made to existing plumbing systems, the new work must be tested or inspected to the degree necessary to disclose leaks and defects in the new work. These tests must be in accordance with Chapter 15 of the Plumbing Subcode.

We want to emphasize that the testing of plumbing systems is considered to be part of the final inspection, and it is necessary that the test requirements of the Plumbing Subcode be properly administered and enforced.
