



NJ PINELANDS COMMISSION SAMPLE NOTICE LANGUAGE

PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS FOR NEW OR INCREASED DIVERSIONS FROM THE KIRKWOOD-COHANSEY AQUIFER (50,000 gallons per day or more per N.J.A.C. 6.86(d))

Instructions for Applicant:

- 1) Fill out the body of the notice with the relevant information regarding the proposed well (diversion). Revisions to this sample language may be necessary in certain situations. We recommend that you submit the draft notice to the Pinelands Commission prior to mailing or publishing.
- 2) A copy of this notice must be sent to all municipal and county clerks with jurisdiction in the Hydrologic Unit Code -11 (HUC-11) watershed where the proposed well will be located.
- 3) Provide proof to the Pinelands Commission that the public notice requirements have been met.
- 4) To demonstrate that the notice requirements have been met, please provide the following to the Pinelands Commission:

A copy of the notice sent to the clerks of each municipality and county in the same Hydrologic Unit Code -11 (HUC-11) watershed as the proposed well/allocation increase. A list of municipalities/counties in each HUC-11 watershed may be found at: [Pinelands Municipalities by HUC-11 Watershed](#)
